


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
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- Implementation 2006 2021
- Average payback time 6,8 years
- Reserved 71,7 mln.m3 from AAC (10% from whole Russian AAC)
- Actually harvesting 89,1 mln.m3 (46% from whole country harvesting)
- 9 projects were completed





Need for investments into new roads:

- Leningrad reg.

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- Arkhangelsk reg.

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Expected changes in Russia in 2015

- Increasing amount of potential wood supply and wood cost reduction
 - New legislation (to be accepted in March April 2015)
 - Law on access to the wood for SMEs (without forest management obligations), 50 rub/m3
 - Law on automatic prolongation of leasing agreement
 - Law on forest auctions for internal timber producers

- Increasing wood harvesting and utilization
 - New law on obligatory bioenergy production to compensate the losses
 - Target to get 2,5% of all energy produced from forest biomass
 - Regional legislation for intensive forest management
 - Intensification of forest management scenarios
 - Forest management = future quality
 - 2. Intensive harvesting = quantity now
