







Export of Russian Forest Products






Share of Finland in the Russian Export of Forest Products




Finland has been the biggest buyer of forest products from Russia in Europe



In the beginning of 2000s, WWF prepared a report on illegal logging in Northwest Russia and Russian-Finnish trade of timber – Attention was paid to hundreds of small Finnish buyers that existed one year or maximum two years



FSC Certification in Russia



About 20% of Russian commercial forests are FSC-certified Biggest Finnish companies have FSC FM and CoC certificates

Launched in 2010 FSC – 2.1 million ha FSC CoC – 29






Finnish Investment in Wood Harvesting in Russian

New Draft Forest Laws that Can Affect Business in Russia

- Draft law giving the right to individual businessmen, small and middle-sized companies to buy logging rights for a site by contracts of purchase – submitted to the Parliament
- Draft law giving the right to prolong forest lease contracts without auctions *submitted to the Parliament*
- Draft law giving the right to conclude forest lease contracts by tenders instead of auctions – developed by the Federal Forestry Agency and submitted to the Government
- Draft law for reimbursing lease holders the cost of building forest infrastructure, purchase of special equipment, and silvicultural operations developed by the Federal Forestry Agency and submitted to the Government



Promoting Intensive Sustainable Forest Management

Federal Forestry Agency established a working group to develop proposals for transferring to intensive sustainable forest management



WWF is launching Boreal Forest Platform as a learning platform to raise awareness of intensive sustainable forest management and best forest management practices for forest companies, forest management units, and other stakeholders
