BuSK objectives

- To reconcile various and often conflictual rural land and natural resource use modes
 - To increase the capacity of remote and sparsely populated communities for sustainable environmental management by involving all stakeholders to land use planning and natural resource use decisions
- By
 - Developing the collection of local knowledge in land use planning with the help of participatory GIS
 - Developing and applying web-based participatory GIS method for sparsely populated areas
 - Combining diverse kind of knowledges and helping the decision makers to select relevant knowledge

Work Packages

- WP1: Indigenous and local knowledge as part of cultural heritage (Arctic Centre, University of Lapland)
- WP2: Knowledge basis for the management of the commons and protected areas (NUI Galway, Ireland)
- WP3: Knowledge basis for creating and developing sustainable community economies (SSD, Faroe Islands)
- WP4: Social license to operate in large scale projects through the co-production of knowledge (UIT The Arctic University of Norway)
