

Activity T1.4 Case study Greenland

Use case centered on an area in Qeqqata Kommunia via the activities 1-3. Local use knowledge of the wilderness is collected via PPGIS and interviews using tablets for school children already in use. Data could include location narratives, mapping of camp sites, foot paths and hunting grounds and other use of wilderness. GINR contributes with scientific and governmental data and knowledge and participates in interviews and mapping activities.
